# <u>Height</u> Weight

1. CDE Variable	Height: body length
	Weight: body weight
2. CDE Definition	
3. Recommended	Height measurement device, Yardstick or stadiometer;
instruments for assessment	scales/estimated
4. Description of measure	Weight: kg or lbs
	Height: cm or inch
5. Permissible values	Body weight: 1-200 kg or 2-440 lbs
	Height: 30-230 cm or 11-90 inch
6. Classification:	Identical
Basic/Intermediate/Advanced	
7. Procedure	Height and weight can be measured or estimated upon
	admission, or alternatively information may be obtained
	from relatives.

### 8. Comments/Special instructions:

Actual measurements are preferred; however this may not always be simple in more severely injured patients. Under these circumstances, obtaining information from relatives is more appropriate.

# 9. Rationale/justification:

Documentation of height and weight is motivated by two reasons:

- 1. the risk of (systemic) complications is greater in the presence of obesity
- 2. body weight is important for calculating required doses of (study) medications.
